

## PRIMARY IN POLK OFFERS CONTESTS

State Representative and Commissioner Races to Be Warm, Belief

DALLAS, April 5.—Polk county will have an exceptionally interesting primary election next month despite the fact that few offices are up for election. There will be several contests for nominations on the republican ticket and one contest on the democratic ballot.

With six candidates in the field, the office of representative from Polk county, 10th district, appears to offer the best chance for a hot battle. Four republicans have filed for the position of representative with three of the contestants well known in this part of the county. The republican candidates are Mrs. Stella J. Henry of Spring Valley, Eben Ray of Gold Creek, Lyle Thomas of West Salem, and R. J. Stumbo of West Salem. Stumbo is connected with the Hollywood theatre in Salem.

Polk county democrats will have two candidates to select their nominee from with T. A. Dunn of Polk Station and Nicklas J. Zylstra of Perrydale entering the primary. Mr. Dunn is well known in party circles although he has never held a public office. He has been a farmer and prune grower for about 25 years and has spent his entire lifetime in Polk county. Zylstra comes from near Perrydale and is a graduate of Perrydale high school. He also attended Oregon State college and the University of Oregon.

No contest for the joint senatorship of Polk and Benton county will be forthcoming until the general election as only one candidate has filed from each party. Dean Walker of Independence is running on the republican ticket and R. W. Hogg of Roza is after the democratic nomination.

The office of county commissioner promises some interest with J. Waldo Finn of McCoy contesting against Frank Farmer, incumbent, for the republican nomination. Fred Gibson of West Salem is the democratic candidate. Mr. Farmer is a stockman and farmer residing in the Oak Grove district and is serving his second term as commissioner. Mr. Finn is also a farmer and stockman and served with Company L overseas. He succeeded the late Conrad Stratton as captain of the company while they were in France. Contest for the office of district attorney will be confined to the republican party with three candidates in the field, Elmer D.

Cook of West Salem and C. F. Gillette of Monmouth are contesting this nomination against Elmer Barnhart of Independence, incumbent. Bruce Spaulding of Dallas is the only democrat entered.

A great deal of interest is expected in this county over the democratic nomination for congressman from the first congressional district with R. R. Turner, city school superintendent, running against John Goss of Marshfield, and W. A. Dezell of Salem. The republican candidates in the primary will be James Mott of Salem, and J. M. Devers, also of Salem.

## Sign Waivers, Silverton Bank

SILVERTON, April 5.—Over 70 per cent of the depositors of the Coolidge and McClaughlin bank have signed the waivers to release funds, according to George Hubbs, chairman of the temporary board of directors elected for re-organization of the bank. It is understood that it may take another two or three weeks to complete securing the 90 per cent desired for the re-organization. The bank was given another extension of time from April 1 to April 15, it was made known this week by the state banking department.

## WENGER ADVOCATES ESTATE PROVISION

"Too many business men fail to provide a means of caring for their wealth after they are gone," declared Karl E. Wenger, trust officer for the United States National bank here, at the Salem Lions club luncheon at the Gray Belle restaurant Thursday. He estimated that "90 per cent of all men die without leaving a will."

"The ideal way to transmit one's wealth to a beneficiary is to set up an estate," Wenger advised. "An estate may consist of insurance policies, securities, real estate or cash. Papers necessary to set up an estate are a will, and an insurance trust agreement, if there is insurance." Insurance made payable to a beneficiary, or an insurance trust agreement, avoids sending insurance payments through probate with resultant expenses, and

averts payment of an inheritance tax, Wenger stated. The speaker outlined other ways of handling estates, but declared the best were by will, trust or gift.
