Interesting Facts...

The Oregon State Motor association has an office in Salem which is located in the lobby of the Marlon Hotel. Information of value and interest to tourists is given from this office.

Grazing is allowed on Oregon National forests under permit. More than 123,000 cattle and horses, over 659,000 sheep and goats graze each year in these forests.

Oregon has a potential water power resource of 3,665,000 horse power. About 11 per cent of the total in the United States, less than 7 per cent of this has been used.

BERRY POOL SHUTS DOWN OWN CANNING

LIBERTY, June 12.—At a meeting of the Salem Berry Growers association Monday night, decision was reached to stop canning operations, which the pool has carried on at Cleary and Hillman's plant in West Salem in an attempt to help growers realize something from the berry crop.

Last deliveries will be made Wednesday, when it is estimated about two-thirds of the crop, except for the young plantings, will have been taken care of. About half the berries from young vines will be harvested by Wednesday.

So far, no market for the canned product has developed, and only 50 tons of the 500-ton pool reached a market as fresh berries.

At the meeting Monday, report was made that some cannery in town has sold prunes at a price that would mean an offer of only \$6 to the grower. Growers were advised not to sell their prunes until the price is set under the tree fruit code, with a very short crop. There is strong hope that 1934 prunes will develop the best price in some years.
