CHICAGO, July 21.—(AP)—Almost 2 cents a bushel rise of wheat values today accompanied an official forecast indicating that next week would bring no substantial relief from drought.

Highest prices of the day were reached by wheat just above trading was ended.

Wheat closed firm, 1-1/4 above yesterday's finish, corn 1-1/4 up, oats 1/4 advanced and provisions varying from 10 cents lower to 5 cents gain.
