

### BARNES TO SPEAK TO W. U. STUDENTS

Ralph W. Barnes, Moscow correspondent for the New York Herald-Tribune and graduate of Willamette university in 1922, will speak at the Willamette chapel period next Tuesday, Dr. F. M. Erickson announced today.

Barnes, who is in Salem on a leave of absence from his duties in Soviet Russia, spoke last Tuesday to a combined meeting of Salem service clubs. When at Willamette, Barnes was a member of Sigma Tau fraternity and in his senior year was captain of the Willamette football team under Coach Bohler. He learned his football during the regime of Coach Bob Mathews. Dr. Robert L. Kelly, executive secretary of the American Association of colleges, may also

speaking at the Willamette chapel next week. Dr. Kelly, according to Dr. Erickson, may stop in Salem long enough to address the Willamette students on his way to Portland to attend the meeting of Oregon and Washington members of the association in Portland next Friday and Saturday. On Friday Bishop Titus Lowe of the northwest Methodist diocese will give a talk on Jason Lee.

### REGISTRATION GAIN SEEN, WILLAMETTE

Students of all classes registered at Willamette university totaled 510 at the close of the third day of registration yesterday, an increase of 21 over the third day figures for last year. As registration climbed to 569 before it was complete last year, this year's enrollment is expected to exceed 600. Yesterday students started the regular routine of classes at 7:45. At the first chapel service of the year, Dr. Frank Erickson, acting president, spoke on the ideals and purposes behind college education after Wanda Landon, student body song queen, had led the students in a number of Willamette songs. The first issue of the Collegian, campus newspaper, also appeared yesterday.

Creamed Tuna in Tomatoes  
Baked Browned Potatoes  
Cheese Biscuits

- Creamed Tuna in Tomatoes  
4 large firm tomatoes  
3 tablespoons butter  
4 tablespoons flour  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1/4 teaspoon paprika  
1/4 teaspoon celery salt  
3 tablespoons chopped green peppers  
1 1/3 cups milk  
2-3 cup tuna
- Wash tomatoes, remove centers. Melt butter and add flour and seasonings. Add milk and cook slowly until thick sauce forms. Stir constantly. Add tuna. Stuff tomatoes. Arrange in shallow pan. Add 1/4 inch water and bake 35 minutes in moderate oven.
- Cheese Biscuits**  
1 1/2 cups flour  
3 teaspoons baking powder  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1-3 cup grated cheese  
3t ablespoons lard  
1/2 cup milk
- Mix flour, baking powder and salt. Add cheese and lard, cutting in with knife. Mixing with knife, slowly add milk. When soft dough forms, pat out until 1/4 inch thick. Cut out biscuits and arrange side by side on greased shallow pan. Bake 10 minutes in moderate oven.
- Sour Cream Date Cookies** (Good For Lunch Boxes)  
2-3 cup fat  
1 1/2 cups sugar  
2 teaspoons cinnamon  
1 teaspoon cloves  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
2 eggs  
1/2 cup sour cream  
2-3 cup chopped dates  
1/2 cup broken nuts  
3/4 cups flour  
1 teaspoon soda
- Cream fat and sugar. Add spices, salt, vanilla, eggs and cream. Beat well. Add rest of ingredi-

ents, mixing lightly. Drop portions from tip of spoon onto greased baking sheets. Space 2 inches apart. Bake 13 minutes in moderate oven.

### No Punishment In Courts for Code Violator

A person who violates the melon and tomato marketing agreement while licensed under the produce dealers and peddlers act, is not subject to be punished under the Oregon agricultural adjustment law, but may have his license revoked, Attorney General Van Winkle held in an opinion handed down Thursday. The opinion was requested by Max Gehlhar, state director of agriculture. In another opinion, Van Winkle held that it was unlawful to take claims from a slough for commercial purposes, even though the slough runs through the property which the person taking the claims owns and on which he pays taxes. This opinion was requested by the state game commission and involved a resident of Lincoln county.
