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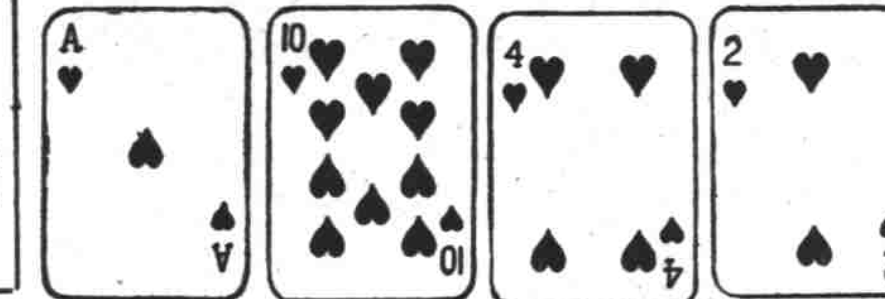

Submit the solution to Mrs. Armstrong, care The Statesman, Mrs. Quinn will judge the answers.

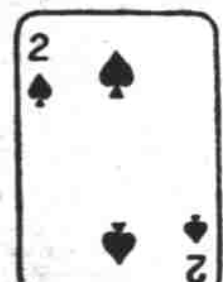

*To justify East's bid, he must have an escape suit to turn to, if doubled. His escape suit is diamonds.

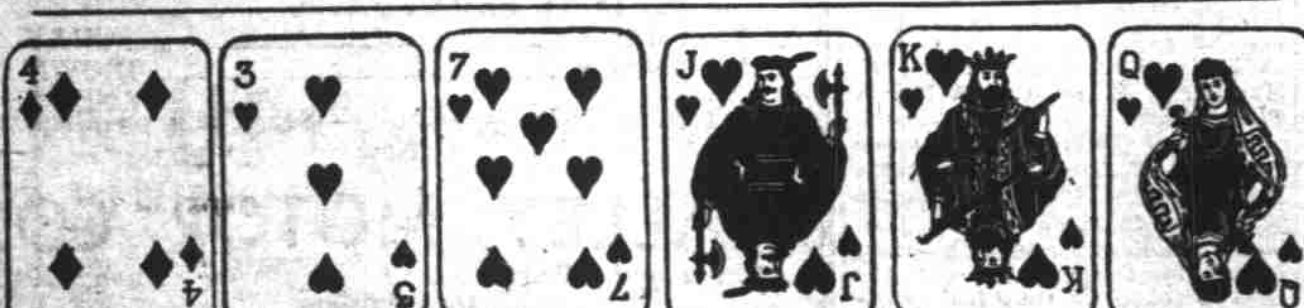

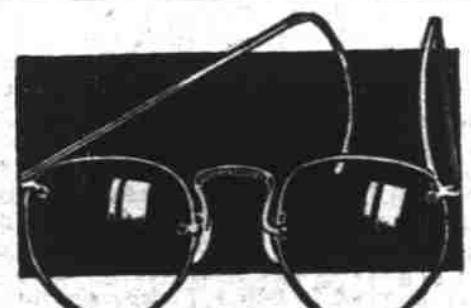

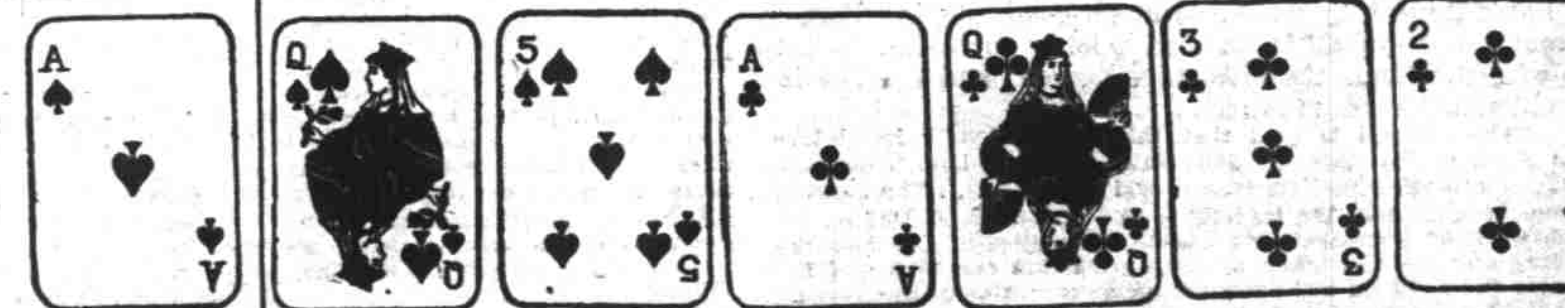
