STRONG TONE FOR CHEESE REPORTED PORTLAND, Nov. 12.—(P)—Continued strong tone for cheese was suggested during the week, which showed not only well maintained prices, but in spots further advances were being scored. Trade conditions in cheese have not been so strong for many a day. The entire trade showed like condition although some retailers were asking when the advances are going to stop as the public is already taking notice of the constant boost. Total markets were unchanged for the week's opening. Trading in the butter market continued to reflect a firm tone here even though prices were generally unchanged for the semi-holiday. Little activity reported. Despite the fact that no change was named for eggs on the produce exchange for the late session, practically open price cutting was shown, which makes the exchange quotation of most nominal character. Keen demand continued to be shown for live chickens with prices firm to higher in spots. Shortage of leghorns was still the dominating factor in the trade here and along the coast. Country killed meat market continued to hold their favorable tone of last week and practically no general change in the price list was shown for the week's opening. That the proposed elimination of country killed meats here would be forced upon the people of Portland by Seattle interests was the statement of one of the local butchers favoring the much talked of ordinance. "This ordinance will do nothing," he said, "whether the people of Portland like it or not." Several carloads of eastern cranberries at least will be received in Pacific northwest markets for the late holiday trade. In the meantime only a steady price was suggested for 1934's, mostly around \$2.50 per quarter bin. box to retailers. Potatoes were steady to firm, and slightly higher for Dutchries. Cauliflower market was a trifle easier with sales to retailers perhaps a nickle less. Pasco lettuce of good quality and well fed was being offered around \$2 crate. Oregon onions were firmly priced but the trade was again importing Yakimas which were much cheaper.
