### Suppers of Holiday Period May Include Plum Pudding Made Over as Frozen Dish

Holiday suppers must vary from dinners, but can contain many of the same things. You have hot plum pudding for Christmas dinner. Why not serve it some other day as a frozen dish? Here's the way:

**Frozen Plum Pudding:** Melt one and a half squares chocolate in double boiler, and add the contents of one can condensed milk slowly, stirring until thick and smooth. Add one and a fourth cups water, and cool. Freeze to a mush in a refrigerator tray, stirring occasionally. Add one cup beaten cream, and freeze again to a mush. Then add two tablespoons chopped dates, two tablespoons chopped raisins, two tablespoons chopped maraschino cherries and two tablespoons chopped nut cherries, and continue freezing. Stir now and then to prevent fruits from settling to bottom. This recipe serves eight.

**Jellied Beet and Cucumber Salad:** Soften one tablespoon gelatin in four tablespoons cold water, dissolve in one cup boiling water, and add one-fourth cup sugar, one-fourth cup vinegar and one-fourth teaspoon salt. Cool. When it begins to set, add diced beets and one cup diced cucumber. Pour into a flat pan wet with cold water, and let harden in refrigerator. Cut in squares and serve on lettuce with a rosette of mayonnaise. This recipe serves eight.
