FORMER HEAD OF CHEMAWA PASSES

CHEMAWA, Jan. 28.—The many friends of ex-Superintendent Thomas W. Potter of the Salem Indian school will be sorry to learn of his death at Los Angeles, January 24. This information was received at Chemawa Saturday from the widow, Mrs. Mary J. Potter.

Mr. Potter came to Chemawa November 20, 1895, and immediately began to rebuild the plant and to put a new spirit into the institution. For nine years he remained at Chemawa and during his incumbency he practically rebuilt the school. He brought to life "The Chemawa American," the school paper, and through its columns he spread the gospel of education for his friends, the American Oregon child, and had many friends throughout the Indian service.

Upon his resignation from the service September 30, 1904, he married Mary J. Smith and they have since made their home at Los Angeles.

150 TREES PLANTED BY BOYS' 4-H GROUP

CENTRAL HOWELL, Jan. 28.—The boys' 4-H forestry club with Oliver Steffen, leader, planted 150 trees Thursday afternoon.

Part of the trees were planted on the school grounds and the rest at the Elvin Herr and Clarence Simmons places. The State college provides the trees which the boys plant.
