BOARD EXPECTS TO EXCEED FIVE CENTS

The Oregon-Washington strawberry growers' control board, meeting in Olympia, Wash., Monday, deferred setting of price on the 1935 crop until the next session around April 1. However, the board is confident that the price will be not less than 5 1/2 cents per pound to the growers for cold pack berries, according to J. W. Baxter, grower member of the board from this district. Baxter, returning to Salem yesterday afternoon, said the control board felt that it was too early to set the price of strawberries at this time. He said he would like to urge growers not to sell their crop until the price is set by the control committee. He reported some broker activity in offering berries at a fictitious price on the eastern market. Outlook for the cold pack berry deal is better than in some time due in part to the following factors, Baxter says: first, the acreage in bearing in the county this year will be about 27,000 acres short of last year; second, last year the holdover was 25,000 barrels on May 22, while it is only 9000 barrels now with several months to go before the new crop comes on.
