Grain, Stock Trend is Uncertain

Traders Cautious, Turnover is Light

Average Unchanged, 49.4, With Industrials up, Utilities Lower

NEW YORK, Sept. 27. — (AP) — Stock market traders were generally cautious in their dealings today and with the exception of buying in a few specialties, left the majority of issues but narrowly changed from the previous close.

Most equities churned idly with small gains or losses, though Standard Gas & Electric issues were under pressure as the company applied for reorganization, with the common down nearly 2 points, and the various preferreds off around 2 to 5.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks, at 49.4, was unchanged, with a small advance in the industrials offset by an equally indecisive loss in utilities while rails held about level.

The wariness with which traders were approaching the making of commitments was mirrored in the continued relatively small volume, 1,123,770 shares in the stock exchange.

Commodities in Line

The irregular to mildly low trend in leading commodities followed closely the stock market pattern. Wheat futures at Chicago were unchanged to 1/2 cent, a bushel higher, while corn was level to 1/4 cent, a bushel lower. Cotton declined 20 to 30 cents a bale.

Bonds likewise turned in a rather colorless performance which left most issues close to previous closing levels.

While freight car loadings for last week, reported today, rose somewhat less than seasonally they were still the best for any week since November, 1931.

International Telephone stock received with only a shade of improvement the announcement that year equalled 33 cents a common share compared with 30 cents in the like period of 1934.

Wool Trading at Boston is Slower

BOSTON, Sept. 27. — (AP) — The Commercial Bulletin will say tomorrow: "The market has slowed down this week appreciably. Prices are generally firm, however, and on medium fleeces a bit stronger."

"The manufacturers have sold ahead for two to three months past and apparently have fairly well covered against their commitments in the raw material."

"Operations in the west are slower, also. Buying of fall wools in California generally is in the range of 14 to 20 cents, depending upon staple, character and condition of the wool."

"Foreign markets are steadier on the new low basis of prices."

"Mohair is very firm but rather quiet on the basis of 50 cents for adult and 60 cents for kid, recently paid in Texas."
