1/4 cup sour cream  
1 cup sugar  
Yolks of 3 eggs  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/4 teaspoon nutmeg  
1 cup pastry flour  
1/4 cup bread flour  
2 cups cream tartar  
1/2 teaspoon soda

Beat yolks until light, add sugar and salt and continue beating. Add cream, then flour mixed with soda, cream of tartar and nutmeg. Have dough as soft as possible. Roll to 1/4 inch thickness and cut with doughnut cutter. Fry in deep fat. The cream of tartar and soda combination tells us this is an old recipe. If followed absolutely you will have delicious doughnuts.
