Gladiolus Thrips Remedy Is Given

Napthalene Flakes Held Best Treatment For Diseased Bulbs

260 Marion

The state department of agriculture has issued the following instructions to gladiolus growers for treatment of bulbs for gladi-(1) Napthalene flakes. This remedy is cheap and effective and is safe both to user and the corns.

The flakes should be used at the

rate of one ounce (four level

tablespoonfuls) for every 100 corms, or one pound to 2,000 has been duly proven and ad-Small lots of bulbs mey .be placed in paper bags or cartons. Marion County, and the under-Sprinkle the flakes over the corms, close the top of the container so as to retain the fumes. For large lots place the corms in trays, scatter the flakes over them, stack trays and cover with a canvas or paper. Do not put corms in tin cans or other airtight containers as the corms are likely to "sweat" and sprout. Before applying the treatment allow the corm to cure sufficiently so that they may be thoroughly cleaned. Burn all tops and trash.

If the flakes are allowed to remain in the corms right up to the planting time some varieties will


