guests drop in? All of the following recipes deserve a place in your files:

Prune Nut Bread

1 tablespoon shortening
1 cup granulated sugar
1 egg, beaten
1/2 cup pruned juice
1/2 cup raisins
2 cups Graham flour
1 cup white flour
6 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 cups cooked, pitted, chopped prunes
1 cup chopped walnuts

Raised Nut Bread

4 cups flour
4 teaspoons baking powder
1 teaspoon salt
1 cup sugar
1 egg, beaten
1/2 cup milk
Sift dry ingredients. Mix egg and milk and add dry ingredients. Add nuts and raisins as desired. Let rise one hour. Bake in slow oven, in high tin, one hour. This is a Canadian recipe.

Orange Nut Bread

2 cups sifted flour
1/2 cup granulated sugar
1/2 cup milk
1/2 cup candied orange peel, cut thin
1/2 cup broken nut meats
1 egg, well beaten
1/2 cup milk
4 tablespoons melted butter
Sift flour once, measure, a d d baking powder, salt and sugar and sift three times. Combine Graham flour, orange peel and nuts and add to first flour mixture. Combine eggs, milk and shortening. Add to flour and nuts. Bake in two greased loaf pans, in a moderate oven, 350 degrees, for one hour or until done. Remove from pans and cool thoroughly. Store overnight before slicing, for bread cannot be cut in thin even slices when it is too fresh. Spread with butter or cream cheese.

Black Walnut Bread

2 cups white flour
1 cup black walnut, coarsely chopped
1/2 cup sugar
1 teaspoon salt
1 cup seedless raisins, not chopped
4 level teaspoons baking powder
1 1/2 cups sweet milk
Sift dry ingredients. Add raisins and chopped nuts and mix well. Beat eggs and add to milk. Then add to dry mixture to make a soft dough. Put into a greased loaf pan, letting it stand 15 or 20 minutes. Then bake in a moderate oven 50 minutes.

DOG LICENSES NOW

DOG OWNERS are again notified that an act of the legislature requires that all dogs over eight months old must be licensed before March 1st to avoid payment of the \$1.00 penalty for delinquency. A license on a male or spayed female dog is now \$1.00; after March 1st this must be increased to \$2.00. Until March 1st female dogs can be licensed for \$2.00; after that the license fee must be increased to \$3.00. Dogs becoming eight months old after March 1st may be licensed without penalty at any time before they become eight months old.
