Jeffrey Opposes Mahoney in Race

PORTLAND, Ore., March 9.—(AP)—John A. Jeffrey, practicing attorney in Portland for 30 years, formally announced his candidacy for the democratic nomination for United States senator today.

He said he would run on a four-point platform: Support of the Townsend pension plan; protection of Columbia river power; restriction of importation of foreign products and support of President Roosevelt.

Willis Mahoney, mayor of Klamath Falls, also has announced his candidacy for the democratic nomination to the office now held by Senator Charles McNary, republican.
