Public Opinion Is Held Main Factor

Golden Rule Applied Will Solve Crime Problem Says Max Alford

Highways will be made safe and crime eradicated only through the force of a public opinion guided by the golden rule. Lieutenant Max Alford of the state police predicted at the Salem Lions club luncheon at the Quaker yesterday. Discussing law enforcement in general, he held that "what you (the public) demand you receive."

Alford suggested "for the betterment of law enforcement and for better cooperation and understanding between the public and the officer, that each of you laymen acquaint yourself more thoroughly with the restrictions under which law enforcement officers work."

"No body of officers, jurists or prosecutors can act contrary to the expressed objectives of the public," the lieutenant pointed out. "You impose upon us obligations and restrictions beyond which we have no authority to go."

Departures From Golden Rule Deplored

Lieutenant Alford decried an "increasing tendency on the part of the civic body generally to disregard the golden rule theory in our social conduct" and declared it "an indictment of the American people" that it should be necessary, for instance, that "the state traffic code must be so specific and detailed." He referred to 42 separate regulations on motor traffic listed as sub-items under the subject of reckless driving.

Alford warned that "if you allow indifference to develop toward general crime as it has toward motor vehicle laws, in a very short time we shall have the same difficulties in regard to the general statutes as we now have with motor laws and highway safety."

Practice of the golden rule, in Lieutenant Alford's opinion, "is the one thing which will come closer to eliminating crime and unsafe highways than anything else."

Joe Brown, who lives in the north end of the county, was halted into justice court yesterday on a charge of receiving and possessing stolen property. Complaint against him was made by N. W. Miller of route three, Junction City, who alleges nine ewes worth \$90 stolen from Miller are in possession of Brown.

Stolen Property Receiving Denied

Claude McKenney was elected to serve as adjutant of Capital Post, American Legion, during a two-month leave of absence granted Adjutant William Bliven who yesterday announced his candidacy for republican nominee as county clerk. The post executive committee at a meeting yesterday declined to accept Bliven's resignation but instead gave him the leave from duty.

McKenney is a past commander of the post.

Sub Mail Carrier Application Open

For the first time in eight years applications are to be received at the local postoffice up to April 1 for the position of substitute mail carrier. It was announced yesterday. Reinstatement of men laid off by depression and transfer of employees from other cities to Salem has prevented the addition of any new helpers to the postoffice staff here during that period, Henry Crawford, postmaster, said.

The opening of examinations for substitute carrier is regarded another indication of better business conditions.

McMahan in Race; Seeks Reelection

Judge L. H. McMahan, first appointed to the circuit court here by Governor Walter M. Pierce, filed yesterday for reelection. He has held the office for two six-year terms. Judge McMahan presides over department one of circuit court in Marion and Linn counties. Long prominent in public affairs in this area, he spent many years as a newspaper editor before taking up the practice of law. Judge McMahan thus far is opposed only by Walter Keyes, Salem attorney. Reports were current yesterday that W. H. Trindle, district attorney, might file as a third candidate for the position.

The circuit judgeship is now a non-partisan office. The salary is \$500 a month.
