Air-Line Highway Bids Are Invited

Bids on the first portion of the new air-line highway between Salem and Portland by way of Butteville to the Fourth street entrance to the metropolis, will be called for opening at the May meeting of the state highway commission in Portland.

This new route, already surveyed by the highway department, will leave the present Pacific highway north of Hubbard and will go under the Southern Pacific tracks and be pointed toward Butteville. Instead of the new route going by way of Willamette, as was first planned, it will run through Butteville to the west side of the Willamette and on to a junction with the West Side highway north of Tigard.

The bridge which will cross the Willamette will cost about \$300,000. An under-crossing is planned for the grade separation north of Hubbard and will be included in the jobs being let this year under the federal government's undercrossing program.

The new air-line route to Portland will shorten the distance between this city and the metropolis by three miles. The bottling-up of traffic in Oregon City will be avoided and when the under-crossings are completed, there will be no direct crossing of railroad tracks.

Group Repudiates McGroarty Slate

SAN FRANCISCO, April 9.—(AP)—Northern California Townsend club managers today "repudiated" the democratic presidential primary ticket of John S. McGroarty, their recently estranged champion in congress, and reaffirmed their faith in Dr. F. Townsend, creator of the old age pension plan.

Club leaders from each of the nine northern California congressional districts, comprising the state area board, also praised E. J. Margrett, state area manager here as "the big-hearted patriot of the Townsend movement."

Knox Law Favored By Beer Handlers

A majority of Salem's retail beer dealers voted their support of the Knox law and opposition to "plans to wreck this law," at a meeting called at the Marion hotel yesterday afternoon by the Salem Food and Beverage Dispensers association, of which Frank P. Marshall is president. The dealers spent two and one-half hours asking questions concerning local, state and federal regulations of the beer trade.

A leading question was, "Is the liquor commission going to revoke the licenses of those here who have been indicted on slot machine or gambling charges?" The dealers were advised by Jack Elliott, of the liquor commission office here, that such action was unlikely. Elliott and Howard Maple, new liquor investigator for the Salem district, both spoke at the meeting.

The beer trade throughout the state is increasingly expressing disfavor of sale of the beverage to minors, even though they be accompanied by parents. F. H. Suss, Portland, secretary-treasurer of the Oregon Food & Beverage Dispensers, Inc., told the gathering. He predicted the next legislature would prohibit beer being served to minors under any condition.

President Visits Storm-torn City

GAINESVILLE, Ga., April 9.—(AP)—President Roosevelt stopped at this tornado-devastated city tonight to check over relief work and to assure cooperation to the south's stricken storm belt.

Major General George V. A. Horn Moseley, commander of the fourth corps area who joined the president in Atlanta, informed him that the situation resulting from the emergency has been met and now begins the task of rehabilitation.

The general estimated the total deaths from the south's tornadoes this season to be nearly 500 with property damage of from \$15,000,000 to \$20,000,000 and more than 2000 homeless.

Service Driveway Limitation Asked

A new attack on the problem of how to limit the size of service driveways in the business district is being studied by several city councilmen. No ordinance has yet been drafted and none is likely to be introduced at the next council session.

Chairman Walter Fuhrer of the traffic committee said yesterday.

The latest proposal is to restrict the size of service station and other driveways according to the amount of street frontage each business place occupies. While the present tentative plan does not so provide, some councilmen are expressing the belief that the bill, when it is finally drawn, should be made retroactive.

Several bills to curtail the size of driveways have been introduced in the council in recent years but none has been enacted.

No Trouble, Says Townsend Leader

PORTLAND, Ore., April 9.—(AP)—John H. Weir, acting head of the Townsend movement in Oregon, minimized importance of recent controversies here today and said "there is a little confusion but no trouble."

Weir was sent to Portland from Los Angeles by Hal Stemons, acting regional director of the \$200-a-month pension plan.

Three Portland men yesterday filed articles of incorporation for the "Old Age Revolving Pension, Ltd." in Oregon and announced they were in control by virtue of a trusteeship.

Weir declined to comment on the new organization. The acting director made it clear recent endorsements of the state Townsend area board are void and that "we're not endorsing any candidates before the primaries."

Senator W. E. Rourke of Newberg announced tonight he will resign at once from the Townsend board of directors of the first congressional district. He is a candidate for the republican nomination for state treasurer.
