3 tablespoons butter
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 cup finely chopped pecans
Mix cornstarch, sugar and salt with enough milk to make a smooth paste. Add the remainder of milk and stir all into the beaten yolks of eggs. Cook until thick in a double boiler. Remove from fire and add butter and vanilla. When nearly cool, add the stiffly beaten egg whites and chopped pecans. Pour into a baked crust and

serve garnished with unsweetened whipped cream.

sentative Knutson (R-Minn.), "the gentleman was delivering a keynote speech for the next campaign."

Leaping to the attack as the North Carolinian concluded, Representative Treadway of Massachusetts, ranking ways and means committee republican, thundered

that the bill was a "monstrosity" and was unsound and disappointing as to revenue.

"It has no good in it, he shouted, 'it is all bad.'"

(The bill has been described by its authors as being capable of raising \$520,000,000 from the new corporate tax plan, with a levy on corporation profits graduated according to percentages of income withheld from distribution, \$100,000,000 from a "windfall" tax on processors who avoided payment of AAA processing taxes; and \$33,000,000 from temporary continuation of excess profits and capital stock taxes.)
