

### Woodrys Lose Appealed Case

### Charles Boag Granted New Trial; Conviction of Pearlman Upheld

Damages awarded Opal Lamb against F. N. Woodry and Don Woodry, in the amount of \$1000, will stand, it was determined when the Oregon supreme court

affirmed Judge L. H. McMahan in an opinion handed down Tuesday. The judgment had been returned after a trial in which Mrs. Lamb alleged Don Woodry went to her home to repossess a cook-stove he had sold her on contract. She alleged that in the act of taking the stove, he treated her roughly. Conviction of Barney Pearlman, alleged dean of Portland's famous "cocktail college" was affirmed in another opinion upholding Judge Jacob Kanzler of the Multnomah county circuit court. Pearlman had been fined \$500 and sentenced to six months in the county jail. In the appeal, he charged that the information on which he was arrested failed to state facts con-

stituting a crime. Boag Gets New Trial. The supreme court reversed conviction of Charles Ray Boag of Yamhill county who was sentenced to serve not to exceed two years in the penitentiary and pay a fine of \$100 for manslaughter. The case was remanded for trial. Reversal was based on introduction of hearsay testimony relating to the manner in which Boag's truck was operated previous to the collision in which Mrs. Olive May was fatally injured.
