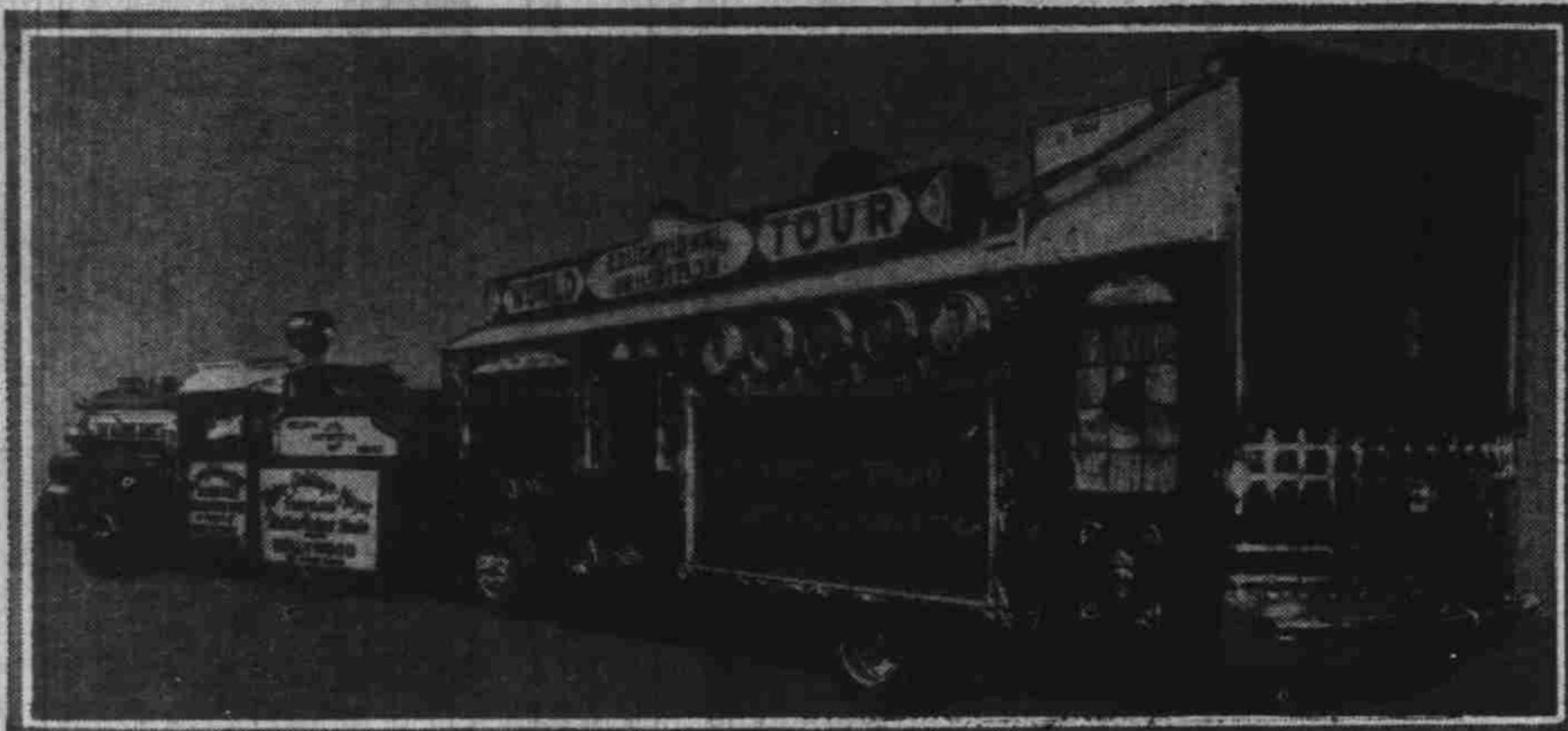
Mr. and Mrs. Blair Stewart (Betty Dando), tenor and lyric soprano respectively, completely charmed the large audience seated on the tennis court and lawn fronting the veranda from which the concert was given. Mrs. A. A. Schram was the accompanist.

Both voices were exquisitely trained. Mr. Stewart was dramatic in his grand opera numbers and injected a delightful pleading in his love songs. Mrs. Stewart's tone was clear and sweet. Their duet numbers seemed to draw out the best qualities of both.

The tenor gave as his encores "Ona Alone" from the "Desert Song" and "The Lord's Prayer." Mrs. Stewart returned to sing "The Last Rose of Summer" and "Take Joy Home."

Both vocalists were outstanding in their Russian selections. Mr. Stewart in "Night" by Rachmaninoff and Mrs. Stewart in "The Rose Enslaves the Nightingale." The entire program courted and won popular favor with familiar and well-liked classical and semi-classical numbers.

Alden T. Powell Called Suddenly

INDEPENDENCE, Aug. 5.—Alden Thomas Powell dropped dead here this afternoon, the physician's report saying he suffered brain concussion. He had been in poor health for some time.

Powell was born in Reedsburg,

Wis., July 2, 1889, and lived there until he was 24 when he moved to South Dakota. He married Josephine Trageser January 17, 1936, at Gary, S. D. Six children were born to the union.

They remained in South Dakota for 11 years, finally moving back to Powell's original home in Wisconsin. The couple came to Oregon in 1912, settling at Lafayette, where they resided several years before coming to Independence.

Besides his wife, Powell is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Charles F. Morris of Seattle, Mrs. Ira C. Min of Independence, and Mrs. Hollis Smith of Dallas; three sons, Harry E. and W. Bryan of Reedsburg, Wis., and Alden T. of Yamhill; one brother, Fred J. Powell of Ironton, Wis., and 14 grandchildren.

Funeral arrangements will be issued later by Keeney Funeral home.

Potts Adds Voice In Rates Protest

George W. Potts, president of Oregon Farmers union, sent the following message to Secretary Henry A. Wallace Tuesday:

"Willamette valley being penalized by high freight rates into drought area. Urge you institute suitable reduction comparable with relief rates afforded adjacent states to permit outlet of large surplus of good quality hay from here."

He sent other messages to railroad heads and other persons whom he thought could help obtain favorable rates for the movement of Willamette valley hay to the drought areas.

Two years ago this district was included in the reduced rate zone, but apparently through oversight, it was omitted this year. In 1934 large quantities of hay moved from this valley to Nebraska, Wyoming and other sections short of forage.

If the rates are reduced this year the valley will be able to furnish hundreds of tons of hay of excellent quality to areas where it is needed.

Studio Rides on Goodyear Tires

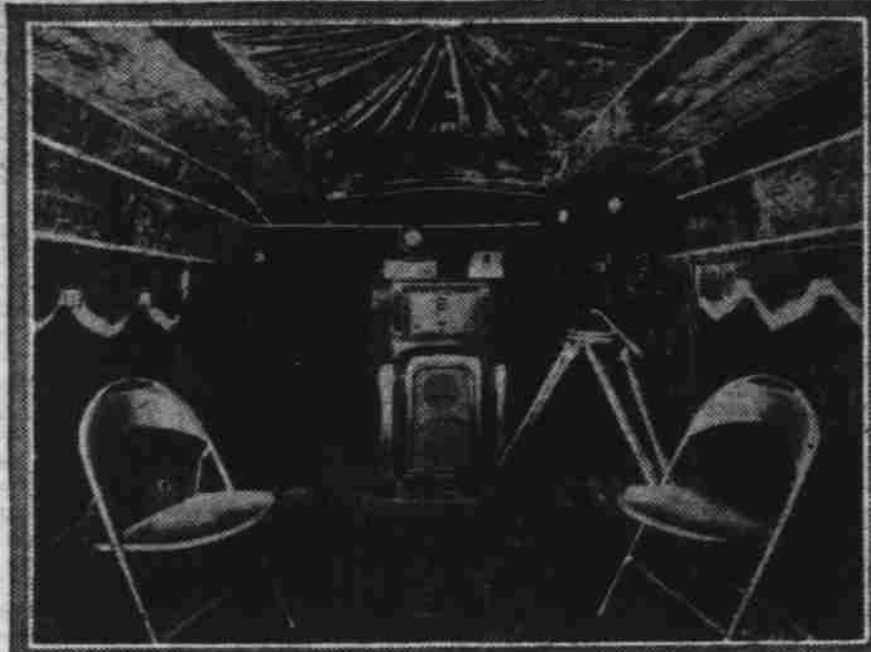

Adjuster Service Unlicensed Here

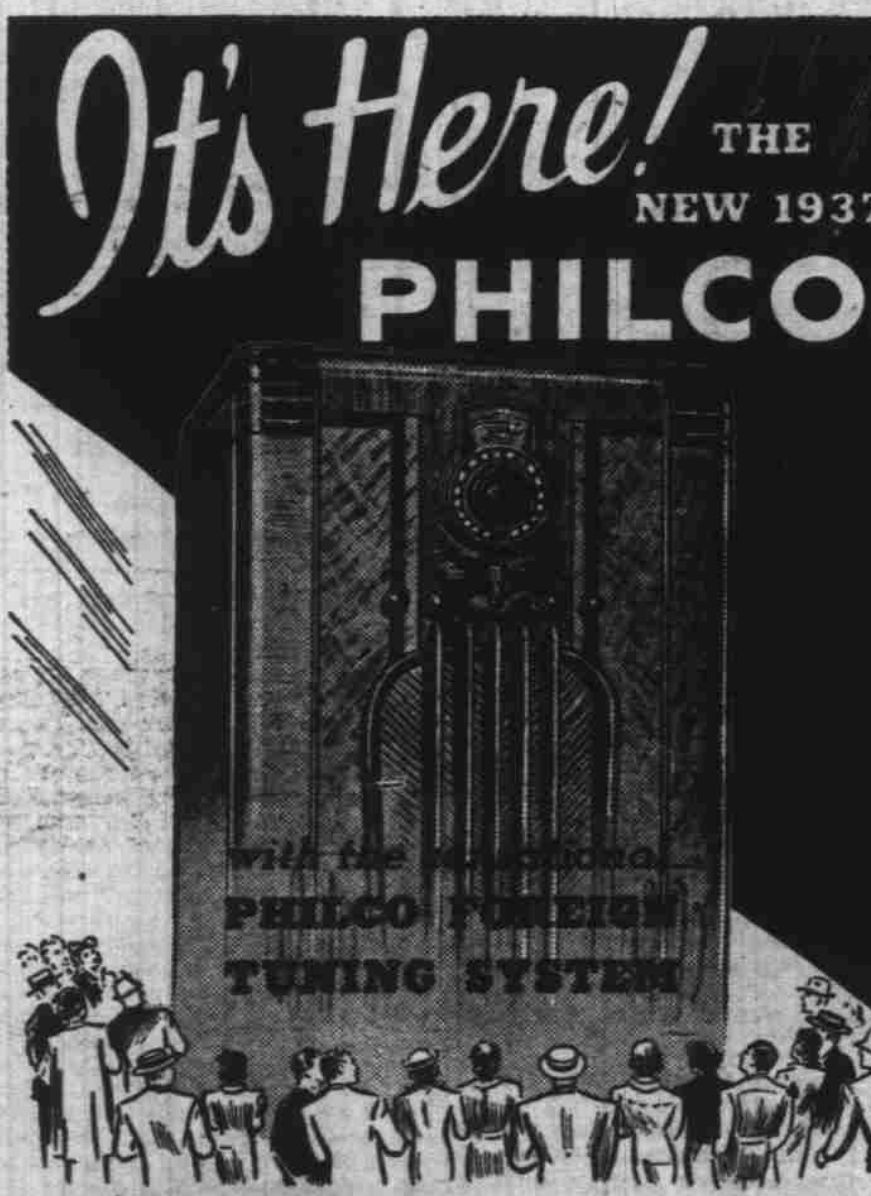
Warning against the operations of the Associated Adjusters of Wisconsin and the universal claims bureau of California, was issued Wednesday by Hugh Earle, state insurance commissioner.

Earle declared that neither of these concerns is licensed to op-

erate in Oregon and that they have no connections that would enable them to assist anyone in entering the insurance adjustment business. Many Oregon citizens have been induced to pay these concerns substantial sums of money, Earle said.

The insurance commissioner said the insurance adjustment profession is one of highly technical nature with only two entrances. One is through the insurance business and the other through the legal profession.
