Forestry Building Project Approved Shops and Office Will Be Built Near Highway

Approval of a project calling for construction of shops and offices for the state board of forestry on state land near the state highway shops at the end of State street was received yesterday by the local WPA office.

The project, for which WPA will furnish \$3,065, will consist of the erection of a warehouse, machine shop, machine storage building, a crew house and an office.

Requests for WPA aid in two projects affecting Salem were forwarded yesterday for approval.

Largest of the two is for the D street news operation for which \$97,969 of federal money is being asked. A sum of \$43,901 is to be furnished by the city but this amount will be reduced by the \$19,115 credit which the city will receive for the use of its tools and machinery. Total estimated expenditure is \$97,969.

The other project calls for inventories, re-classifying and restocking 40,000 volumes at the Salem public library. Since it is largely a labor project \$4242 federal money will be furnished to go with \$185 put up by the sponsor. The total project calls for \$4427.
