

Only Three Linn County Towns Get Higher Assessments in 1937 Levies; Albany School District up 3 Mills

ALBANY, Nov. 19. — W. C. Templeton, Linn county assessor, has announced the 1937 tax levies for Linn county municipalities, only three of which show a higher miliage than those for 1936. The total amounts which will be raised by these levies in Albany and school district No. 5, which includes Albany, will be \$69,413.10, and \$75,872.25.

The Albany levy which is 18.1 mills, is one tenth of a mill greater than that of last year, and the total tax is \$3,779.43 greater. In school district No. 5, the levy is increased from 15.3 mills to 18.1 mills making a total of \$10,444.93 more to be raised than for 1936.

The increase in the school levy is due, according to school authorities, to the increased debt service, which it is claimed is at its peak this year.
