

## Cascade Pass Is Kept Open

Winter Losses in McKenzie Fight But Makes Gain Throughout State

Oregon shivered tonight as the temperature settled down below zero in some sections, but at one point winter took a beating. Snow plows, fighting drifts from December snows, tonight maintained a passage over the McKenzie pass between Eugene and Bend. It is the latest date in history traffic has found a path over this high Cascade mountain route.

Last year the highway department ordered the road closed on December 30. Officials said tonight, however, a gathering storm

might block the narrow lane over the lava fields until spring. Much of the road now is open only to one-way traffic.

Klamath Sub-Zero  
Temperatures shivered below zero in the Klamath country. At Gerber dam in the east end of Klamath county, the temperature nosed to 14 below. Tulake, just across the line in northern California, reported five below. Klamath Falls had 11 degrees above zero, the coldest point of the season.

Freezing temperature struck Marshfield for the first time this winter, but at that the thermometer didn't get below 31. An icy fog covered the southwestern Oregon coastal region.

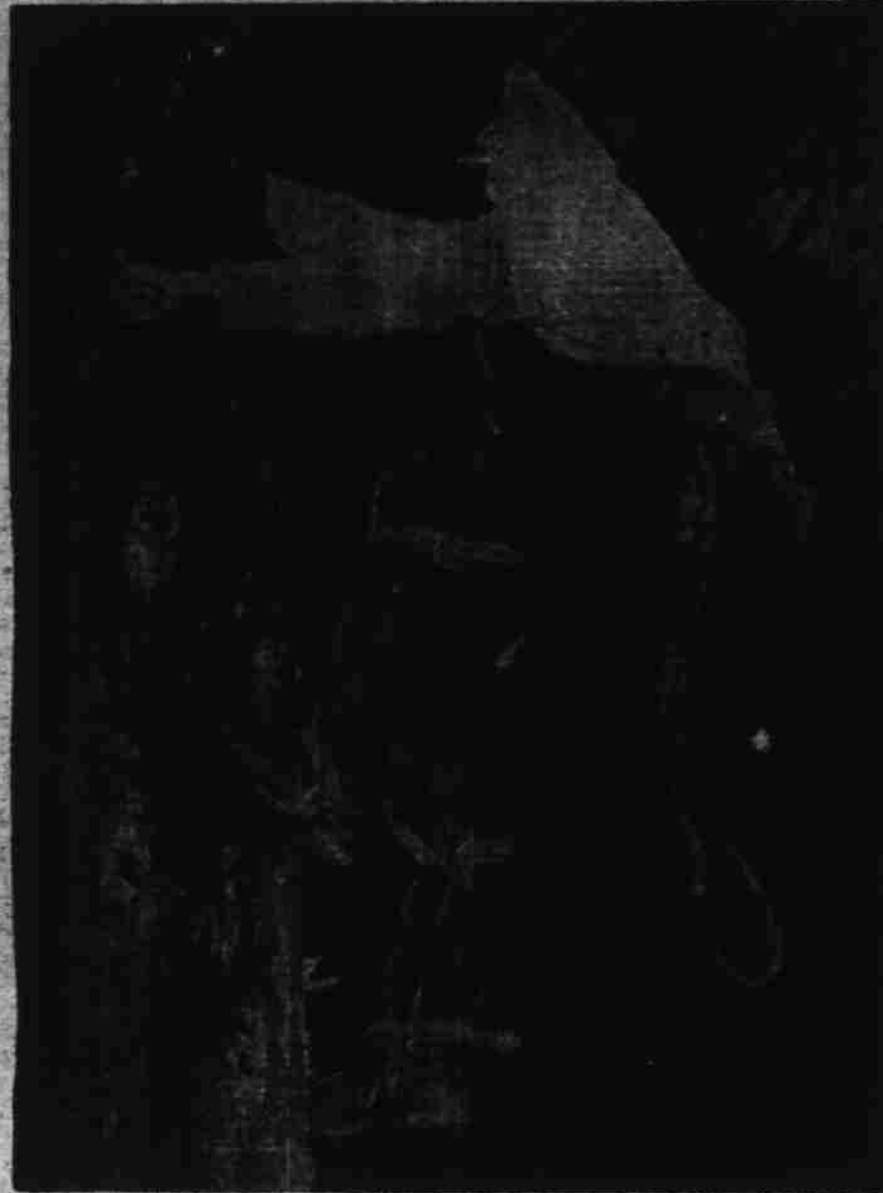
Baker and Bend turned in marks of 15 degrees above.

## Adult Classes to Be Resumed Soon

The adult education and recreation classes of Marion county, according to County Supervisor Earl Litwiller, will resume work January 4. In addition to the courses previously offered there will be several new ones; others are being completely reorganized.

The new courses are practical woodwork and foods. Other classes recently organized, for which enrollments are still being taken are health rebuilding, Diesel engines and pastel drawing.

Several changes in class schedules are also effective. Hereafter the beginning first aid class will meet Tuesday nights but the advanced first aid group will continue on Thursday, as usual. The gym class has been changed to Monday evening. The interpretive reading class, providing instruction in choral reading, religious drama, expression and radio entertaining, is to be held Monday nights. The speech building class is scheduled for Thursday nights. On Wednesday nights there is to be a public speakers' class at the Y. M. C. A. Religious education continues on Tuesday nights at the high school and at the Y. M. C. A. on Tuesday afternoons.

## Advance in Farm Prices Recorded

CORVALLIS, Dec. 31—(AP)—A chart of the Oregon State college agricultural extension service today revealed an advance of farm prices through mid-December and a 12-point increase in the November price levels over a year ago.

Compared with a year ago, the November index was 84 percent of the 1926-30 average.

Factory payrolls over the county moved up 14 points and general business 15 points.

The chart revealed a 5-point advance in farm costs. Purchasing power of farm products in exchange for commodities was nearly normal, reaching 94 percent of the pre-war average.

Students said it was one of the most favorable relationships for agriculture since 1929. The difference was slightly narrower for August through October.

## Lockhart Facing Charge of Fraud

PORTLAND, Dec. 31—(AP)—F. L. Lockhart, assistant United States attorney at the United States marshal's office today on charges of unlawfully representing himself as an officer of the social security board.

## Million and Half Is Job Insurance Income For Year

The state unemployment compensation insurance commission will close its books for the first year of its existence with receipts of more than \$1,530,000, D. Bulmore, administrator, announced Thursday.

Expenses of the department, including the purchase of equipment, will not exceed \$100,000. Bulmore said a few more 1936 payments were yet to be made which would boost the total receipts to \$1,550,000.

## Ex-Boxing Mogul Held as Burglar

ASTORIA, Dec. 31—(AP)—Police detained James Campbell, 36, ex-boxing promoter, on a charge of breaking into and robbing the Trans-Columbia Ferry Tourist at the dock.

State Trooper Myron Jones said Campbell admitted theft of a slot machine and a quantity of cigars and cigarettes.

George Gehry, 65, died of injuries received when a car struck him December 24.

Enid Fox, 22, suffered fatal injuries December 22. An auto hit him as he crossed an intersection.
