Attorney Urges Building Be Financed Wholly Within County

with him in principle, asserted a courthouse program could not be put over without federal aid. "I don't think there's a chance in the world of getting this project unless we get a grant," County Assessor R. "Bud" Shelton broke in, saying he had made it a point to talk to people in all parts of the county about the building proposal. "A big percentage of the taxpayers are going to vote for it if you get a grant."

Commissioner Roy S. Nelson averred "nine out of 10 people would insist on our applying for PWA money" and Committee-man Cuyler Van Patten declared "the people are going after this federal money hot and heavy."

Only One Change in Plans Is Favored
The committee went ahead with plans to submit an application for a grant to the PWA. Only one major change in building plans, that for the future, was effected. The committee decided that the building should be so located that instead of enlarging upon the T-shape contemplated for the first unit, an east unit could be added at a future date to convert the building into a symmetrical H-shape.

Other changes included providing a 25 by 45-foot vault for the clerk's office, enlarging the department one circuit court room, rearranging the assessor's assigned space and giving the treasurer a more accessible location. The ground plan was left unchanged as far as present contemplated construction was concerned and no change was made in the number of floors, which will be a full basement, three full floors and a fourth story consisting of jail, jury room and court room.

Validity of 1937 Law To Be Tested
Ground area of the building as now planned will be approximately 15,400 square feet as against 6,000 in the old courthouse.

William S. Walton, the committee's financial adviser, said bank attorneys would be asked to pass upon the validity of the Deschutes county courthouse act, which the last legislature enacted and which applied to all counties contemplating construction. Walton said it would be an easy matter to finance the county's share of the cost by issuing short term notes and levying a tax extending over a five or six-year period to redeem them.

The committee will reconvene as soon as the architects have re-drafted plans to conform to last night's alterations.

Loggers Vote For Immediate Strike

PORTLAND, Ore., April 22—(AP)—Logging employees of the Clark & Wilson Lumber company at Wilkes voted 50 to 71 to go to strike tomorrow morning.

Via Ennis, president of the Veronia local, said the loggers sought the same concessions made to the company's mill workers who began receiving an hourly wage increase of 7½ cent March 16.

Possibility that the strike would spread to other operations of the company was raised in a statement by the executive board of the large Portland local that "the loggers will be supported by the Clark & Wilson men in Portland."

The company operates a sawmill at Linnton employing approximately 500 men, and employs 450 at its Prescott mill.
