

### Capitol Costs Are Revealed

Total to Date \$363,932, six per Cent Listed Administrative

Almost exactly 6 per cent of the total expenditure in connection with the state capitol reconstruction up to May 18 had been administrative costs, state department records showed Thursday. The total outlay was \$363,932.77 of which \$21,780.26 was administrative cost. This included the item of the scale model of the new capitol.

Work on the capitol building started last September although operations of the capitol reconstruction commission were in progress for several months previously. The total appropriation for the capitol construction, including the federal grant, was \$2,500,000.

The largest item of administrative cost up to May 18 included salaries for the executive secretary, clerk of the works and other clerks and stenographers. Alton Bassett, executive secretary, received \$4993.40. He has received a salary of \$390 a month but this was increased to \$350 at the last meeting of the commission.

The clerk of the works has received \$2320 and clerks and stenographers \$3683.26.

Travel expenses of the capitol

reconstruction commission aggregated \$4841.53. Travel costs of other persons totalled \$211.39.

Other substantial administrative costs included: Office rentals \$683.20, postage and express \$2353.48, telephone and telegraph \$669.67, rental of equipment and furnishings \$28, printing and office supplies \$732.46, advertisement for bids \$1093.81, audits \$65.97, surety bond premiums \$75, miscellaneous expenses \$135.58, office furniture and equipment \$469.41, and scale model of capitol building \$1347.50.

So-called preliminary expenses aggregated \$13,565.93 and included:

Advisory architect, services and expenses, \$2923.72; awards \$7500 and other expenses \$2141.31.

Payments of architects fees, tests, etc., were:

Trowbridge, Livingston and Francis Kealey, New York architects, payment on contract, \$49,811.38; revision of plans and special drawings \$1661.56. Additional blue prints \$615.82. Whitehouse and Church, Portland architects, payments on contract, \$24,995.63; architects travel expense \$2184.82, tests and borings \$516.69.

Artists Partly Paid  
Payments on contract, involving murals and decorative paintings aggregated \$3541.50, with other payments of \$2796.40 for sculptor and carvings and for models for certain bronze work.

Construction payments on contracts totalled \$241,218.79 and other costs \$1234.32.

The building will not be completed until August, 1938, under the terms of the contract.

Increase of Bassett's salary from \$300 to \$350 a month was opposed by H. H. Olinger, Salem member of the capitol reconstruction commission.

### United States now Sole Defender of Freedom of Press, Declares Wharton

OREGON STATE COLLEGE, Corvallis, May 20.—The U. S. now remains as the sole defender of freedom of the press since England's treatment of former King Edward's abdication by strict censorship, Wallace Wharton told active and associate members of Sigma Delta Chi, professional honorary society for men in journalism, at their annual founder's day banquet last night in the Benton hotel. Wharton is executive secretary to Governor Martin.

"If democracy is to succeed in any country it can do so only through the free discussion of all public matters," Wharton remarked during his informal talk regarding the press and the government. His closing advice to the honor society men was to "Be a skeptic, but not necessarily a cynic."

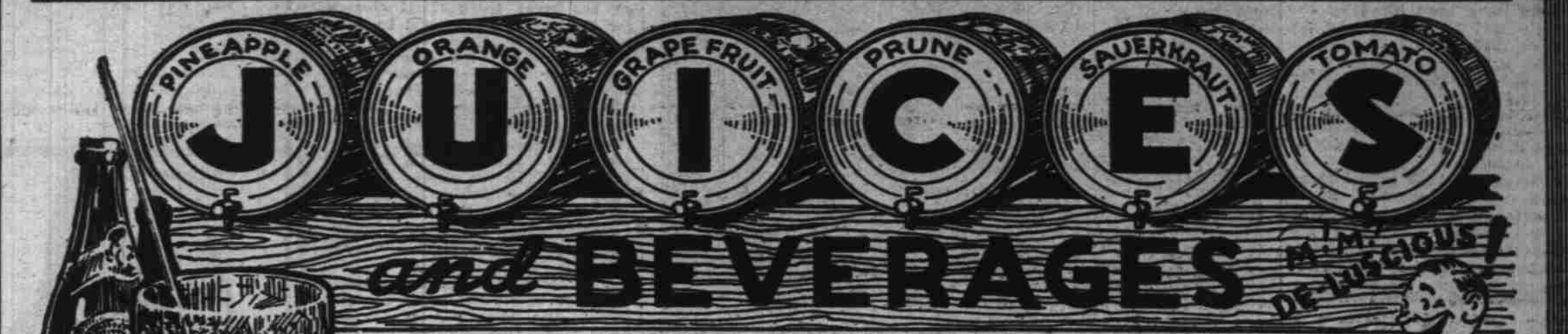
