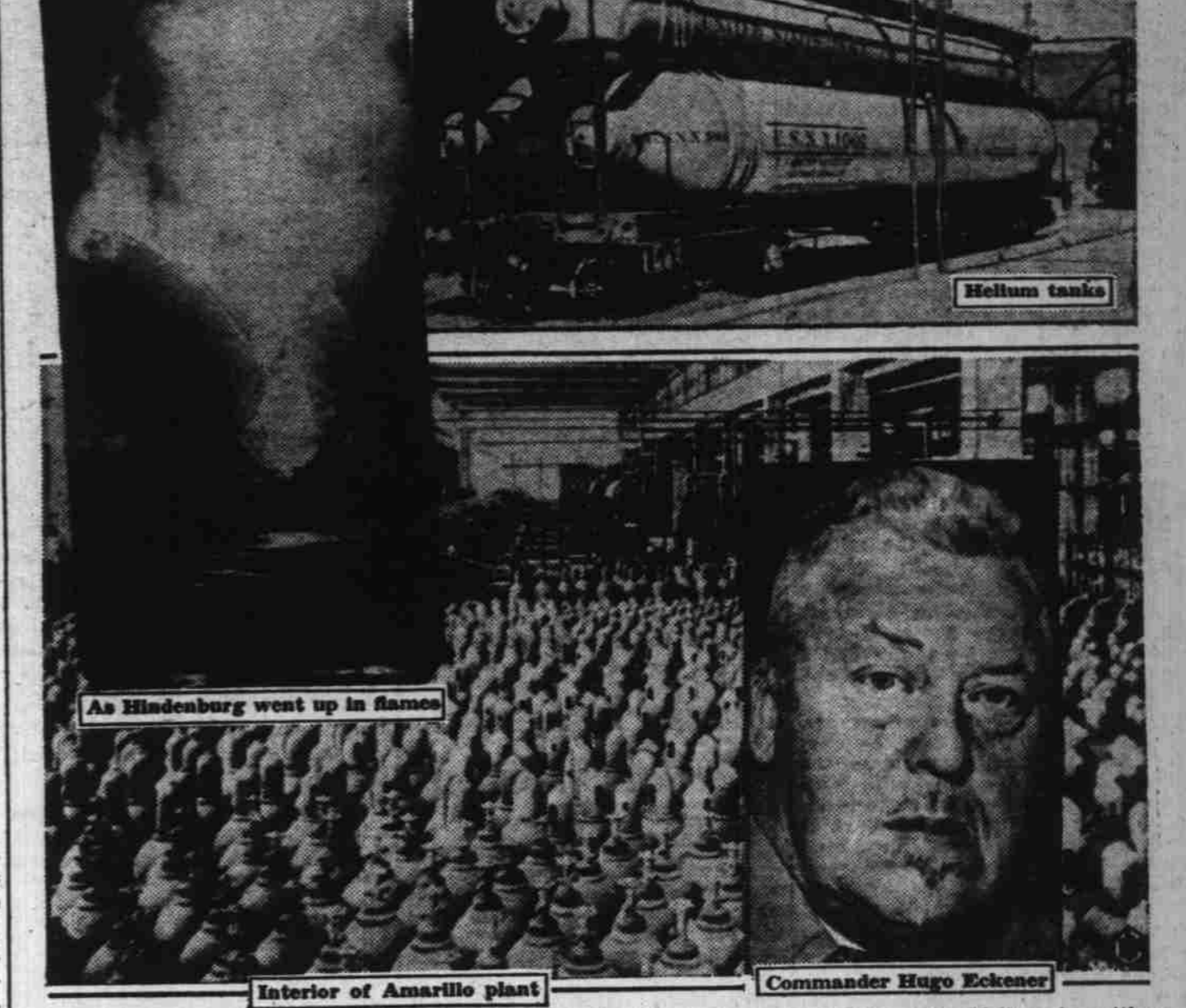

Use of Hydrogen in Airships Banned After Blast

As a result of the tragic end of the German dirigible, Hindenburg, which went up in flames at Lakehurst, N. J., Commander Hugo Eckener has banned the use of hydrogen in all future commercial dirigibles and is now discussing, with a special commission appointed by President Roosevelt, means of obtaining helium from United States which has a virtual monopoly on the gas.

Helium is neither inflammable nor explosive and has about 90 per cent of the lifting power of oxygen. The greatest known reserve of helium is located near Amarillo, Tex., where the government maintains a plant to produce the gas for military purposes. Another important reserve is located in Utah.
