May Seed Cover Crops in August

Orchard cover crops should be seeded during the last of August, and in prune orchards seeding should be done before picking begins, according to a report from the county agent's office.

Full seedings of vetch and oats for hay next year or in orchards as a cover crop will enable farmers to collect 1937 agricultural conservation payments, the report said. The only restriction is that the vetch and oats seeding payment can not be made on land that has earned some other payment during 1937. However, additional lime and super phosphate payments may be earned on the same land.
