JEFFERSON—At the meeting of the city council Monday night, it was voted to retain the following officers: Water superintendent, A. Wilson; water rental collector, Miss Anna Klampe; city attorney, David Wied. Mrs. Martha Hutchings was elected city treasurer, in the place of George C. Mason, who resigned because of illness. Ladd & Bush bank was made the depositor for the city's funds.
