

Seek PWA Aid On Road Jobs

Highway Board to Make
Request to Speed up
Job Completion

PORTLAND, July 21—(AP)—PWA assistance on eight road projects in Oregon will be requested, the state road commission decided yesterday. Help will be asked for jobs that would be delayed otherwise because of lack of state funds. Included were: Gilliam county—Rock Creek-Morrow county line, grading, \$55,000. Umatilla county—Umatilla river, bridge, \$40,500. Lake county—Klamath Falls-Lakeview, grading, \$100,000. Washington county—Barbur boulevard-Lake Forest, grading, \$95,500. Coos county—Cape Arago.

surfacing and oiling, \$40,000. Douglas county—Umpqua river, two bridges, \$120,000. Jefferson county—Madras-Warm Springs, surfacing, \$95,000. Baker county—Baker-Cornucopia, surfacing and oiling, \$50,000. The commission today opened bids on three projects. Low bidders were: Deschutes county, 1.2 miles grading and .7 mile surfacing Bend section of Century drive, secondary, Babler Bros., Portland, \$13,714. Klamath county, 1.51 miles road mix surfacing Malone-California line section of Whitney county road, Clifford A. Dunn, Klamath Falls, \$35,527. Portland, widening of Sandy boulevard between 14th and 45th avenues, Kern & Kibbe, Portland, \$104,889.

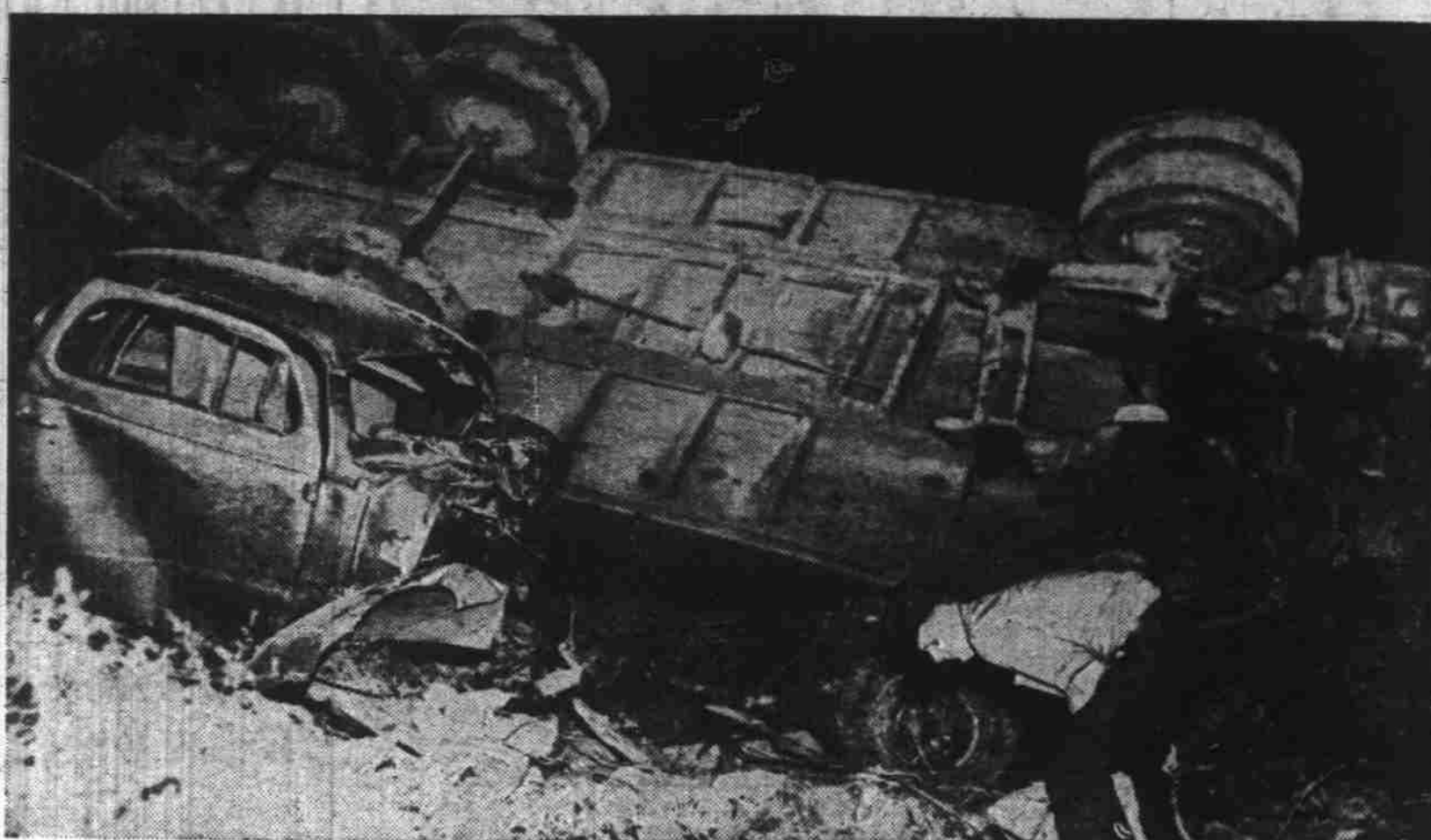

8 Heavy Cruisers Due at Portland

PORTLAND, Ore., July 21—(AP)—Eight heavy cruisers, led by the flagship Indianapolis, and eight modern destroyers, led by their flagships Aylwin and Phelps are expected to dock on Portland's waterfront tomorrow afternoon, inaugurating the city's annual fleet week.

Three auxiliary boats, the repair ship Medusa, hospital ship Relief and the supply ship Arctic arrived today.

The visit will bring between 7500 and 10,000 men and officers to Portland.

NEW YORK, July 21—(AP)—Daniel J. Doherty, national commander of the American Legion, was loudly hissed tonight when he spoke of "red professors" in a speech before a joint conference on education at Columbia university's teachers college.

Dean William F. Russell of the college denounced the demonstrators, saying from the platform at the conclusion of Doherty's speech:

"To those who had the discourtesy to hiss I express my contempt."

Doherty had appeared with a prepared speech in which he made indirect answer to Prof. William Gellerman of Northwestern university whose thesis recently published by Columbia Teachers college denounced Legion leaders as "reactionary" and as giving the rank and file little voice in Legion policies.

From that text, however, he departed frequently.

The outbreak of hissing occurred as, speaking of public apathy over certain "domestic problems," he added that but for apathy "we would not have what is known as red professors."

As the noise subsided he went on:

"If it were not for freedom and democracy in this country I would not have the freedom to say these things and you would not have the right to hiss."

Port Orford Line Permit Cancelled

WASHINGTON, July 21—(AP)—A certificate authorizing the Gold Coast railroad to build a line from Port Orford on the coast to a Southern Pacific mainline connection at Leland, about 90 miles away in Curry and Josephine counties, was cancelled today by the interstate commerce commission.

The commission also dismissed an application by the city of Grants Pass and the Crescent City harbor district for authority to acquire the California & Oregon coast railroad, extending from Grants Pass to Waters creek, 14.6 miles.

They wanted to extend this line from Waters creek to the Oregon-California boundary, 30.4 miles, and from the state line to Crescent City, 51.2 miles in Del Norte county, California.
