Declaring, "The whole world is reminded by your action that our navy will stick by its guns," Admiral Edward C. Kalbfus pinned the navy cross on Lieutenant Arthur F. Anders for his bravery and heroic action during the Panay bombing episode. The ceremony took place on the quarterdeck of the USS Mississippi while the entire ship's company stood at attention. Admiral Kalbfus then read a citation by the secretary of the navy, which ended: "His action on this occasion characterized conduct far above and beyond the call of ordinary duty." Turk Egg Depot Is Needed now

Cosby Tells Hatcherymen Mart Good if Central Station Obtained

CORVALLIS, Sept. 1—(P)—Oregon turkey growers would have an opportunity of supplying hatcherymen outside the state with large quantities of hatching eggs if some central assembling and shipping organization were formed. H. E. Cosby, head of Oregon State college's poultry department, told 200 poultrymen today at the third annual industry convention.

He said he had received inquiries for as many as half a million eggs at a time. J. C. Leedy, growers' field man, said preliminary steps to set up such an organization had been taken.

Broiler Mart Lacking
Lack of an established market on broiler turkeys, making production hazardous, was deplored by C. W. Norton, Portland dealer. Noel L. Bennion, extension specialist, advocated separating hens from toms before fattening and marketing the hens as soon as they are ready. This eliminates expensive late feeding.
