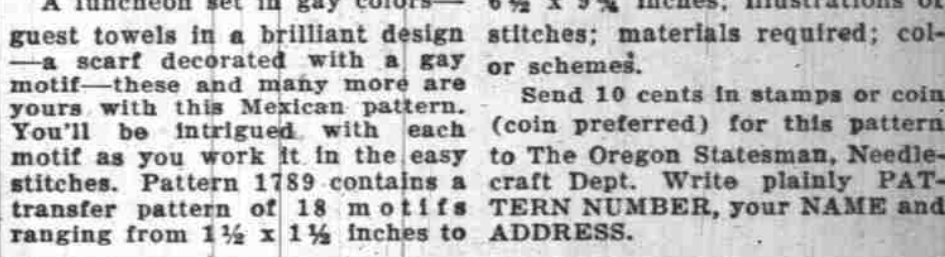
For several hours before the services, the body will lie in state in the auditorium of the Labor Temple. Labor leaders of the Oregon will be active and honorary pallbearers.
