Interesting Things to Be Viewed by Visitors at Hospital Today

In celebration of National Hospital day today hundreds of visitors will be entertained at Salem's hospitals, and will be shown the excellent equipment available to people of the vicinity.

The institution has much equipment usually found only in larger hospitals and boasts an excellent staff of graduate nurses.

Last year was the busiest one known thus far by the Salem General hospital's obstetrical department which takes up almost an entire floor in the building.

Obstetrical Rooms Busy
On the floor are two lying-in rooms, two delivery rooms and five incubators.

department is a post graduate of DeLee, the Chicago Lying-in hospital, one of the nation's outstanding obstetrical institutions of the country.

There are 73 adult beds in the hospital. On the third floor a newly painted children's ward accommodates young patients.

Special Equipment
The Salem General hospital has a well equipped surgery with two major and minor operating rooms.

Special equipment includes five incubators, an oxygen tent, an oxygen box, ether vaporizer and suction used in eye, nose and throat surgery.

Enjoys High Rating
Salem General is a standardized hospital, one of the 23 in Oregon, which means that it is recognized by the American College of Surgeons and the American Medical Society.
