All ordinances granting permission for any unusual use of the street have been repealed by Ordinances No. 3135, as amended by Ordinance No. 3208, and Ordinance No. 3401, Resolution No. 4075, adopted by the Common Council July 3, 1939, instructs the city departments to remove all illegal obstructions in and over streets immediately and authorizes the City Recorder to place in the daily newspapers notices to owners and tenants that immediate compliance with such ordinances must be made, except where substantial expense or danger would prevent immediate removal such owners and tenants would then be allowed additional time but in no event later than SEPTEMBER 20, 1939. 


