SILVERTON—Breta Thompson Rosheim, 74, died Wednesday at her home on East Hill at Silvertown. Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Ekman chapel, with Rev. M. J. K. Fuhr in charge. Interment will be at the Belcrest cemetery.

Breta Thompson was born November 20, 1865, and was married to G. J. Rosheim November 9, 1882. They came to Silvertown 40 years ago, living first in the Brush Creek district.

All her children, called to her bedside by her serious illness, arrived before her death.
