Greek Submarine Gets Credit for Two Sinkings

A Greek submarine, already credited with having sunk 30,000 tons of Italian shipping, was reported by the Greek ministry of marine to have torpedoed another, a loaded 10,000-ton "enemy" ship despite a warship escort. It said the vessel was sunk in the Bay of Valona on the night of January 28.

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Stations between 880 and 1450

kilocycles will generally advance 30 kilocycles (three channels); 25 stations will advance 40 kilocycles (four channels).

Clear channel stations will shift from 1460-1490 to 1500-1530 kilocycles.

Local stations on 1500 kilocycles will move down one channel to 1490 kilocycles.

Because of engineering problems, the Hamden group of stations have not been included in the general shifts, and have been dealt with individually.
