ASTORIA, Ore., April 30.—(P)—Gillnet boats averaged a scant 125 pounds of fish for the first day of fishing, lower Columbia river packers reported Wednesday. Receipts also were light farther up the river. Clear water was blamed for the poor early fishing which started at noon Tuesday.

Packers posted ocean troll salmon prices Wednesday: 13½ cents a pound for dressed large chinook salmon, 7½ cents for small salmon, 5½ for white colored chinook. An offer of 7½ was made for silversides.
