DAYTON—Five acres of table beets for the Blue Lake cannery have been planted at the Albert May farm in the Webfoot district.

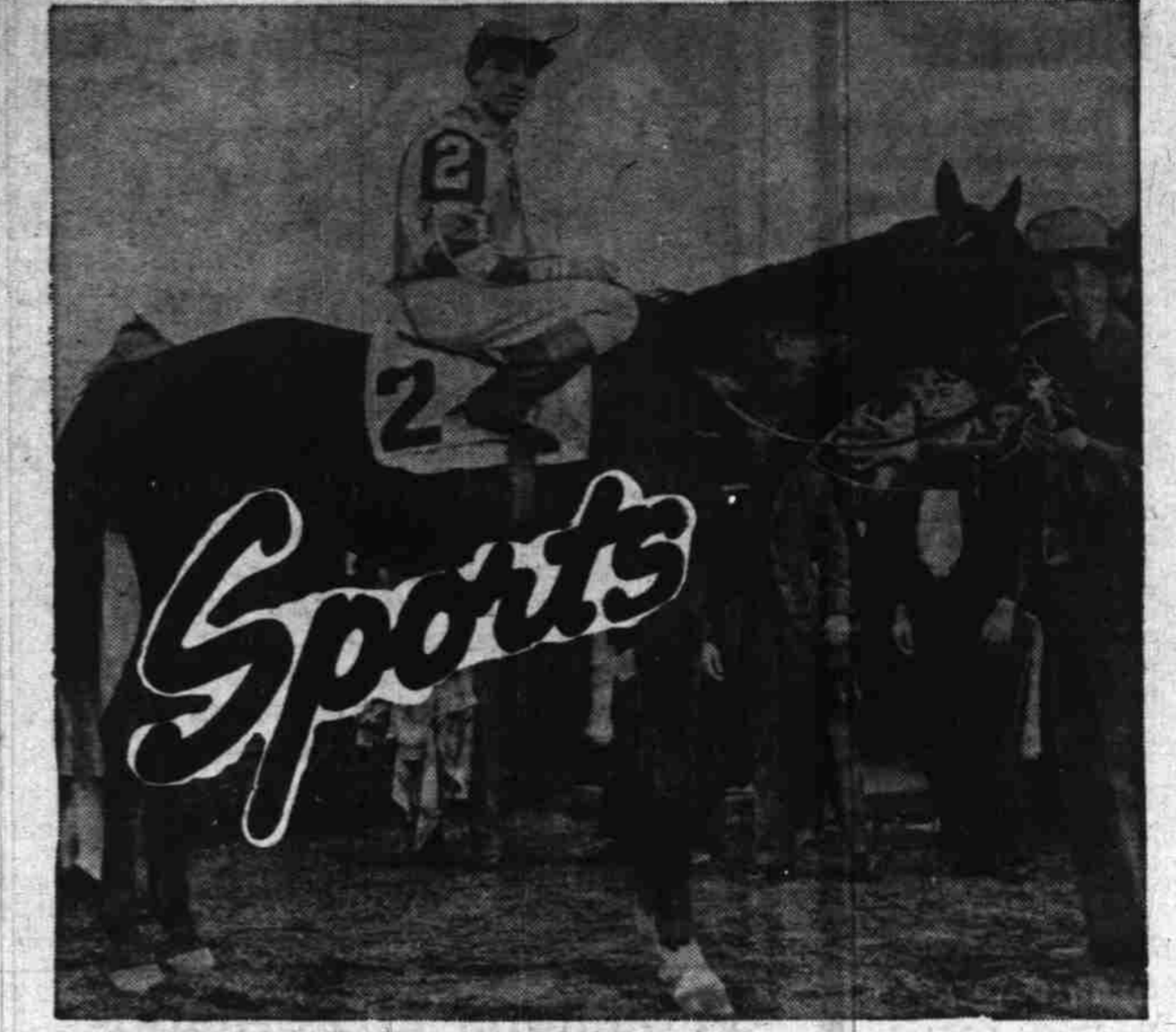
