Soy Beans Set Record

CHICAGO, Sept. 8—(AP)—Led by soybeans, which soared 6 cents a bushel, the limit permitted in one day, all grain futures prices Monday advanced about two cents to the highest levels since 1937. Soybeans were the highest in the six years during which there has been trading in futures on the board of trade.

Straw From Pea And Vetch Seed Is Valuable

Straw left after harvesting pea and vetch seed crops is valuable, according to Robert E. Rieder, secretary of the county AAA committee.

One ton of hairy vetch straw, already spread, is equal to four tons of barnyard manure in plant food value, Rieder said. Citing recommendations just received from Oregon State college extension specialists, who make up the state AAA technical committee, he added that proper use of this straw can be measured in terms of actual cash.

Labor Shortage Less Critical

With the general drift of pickers into the area and through the generous help of several hundred persons from Portland, the harvest problem in the Salem area is not as critical as it was last week, although additional help is still needed, W. H. Baillie manager of the Salem office of the state employment service, said Monday afternoon.

Although the bean harvest is tapering off workers are still being transported to the fields, he said. Still very much in demand are workers for the prune orchards, with the harvest fast getting past its prime.

"Hop growers, still in need of several thousand pickers, are not in as dire straits as they were a week ago, Baillie pointed out, and are very grateful for the influx of workers this weekend.

Opening Filbert Prices Revealed

PORTLAND, Sept. 8—(AP)—Opening filbert prices will range from 16¢ to 21¢ a pound, the Pacific Nutgrowers' cooperative, Dundee, announced Monday. Quotations on jumbo Barcelonas and Brixnuts were 21¢ each and on jumb Duchillys 20¢ each. The prices are 2¢ to 3¢ a pound more than last year on some varieties, A. Jacobson, general manager, said.

Linn Valuation Rises

ALBANY, Sept. 8—(AP)—Linn county's assessed valuation increased \$713,170 to \$23,425,620 this year as a result of wood-working plants locating in the county in the past year.

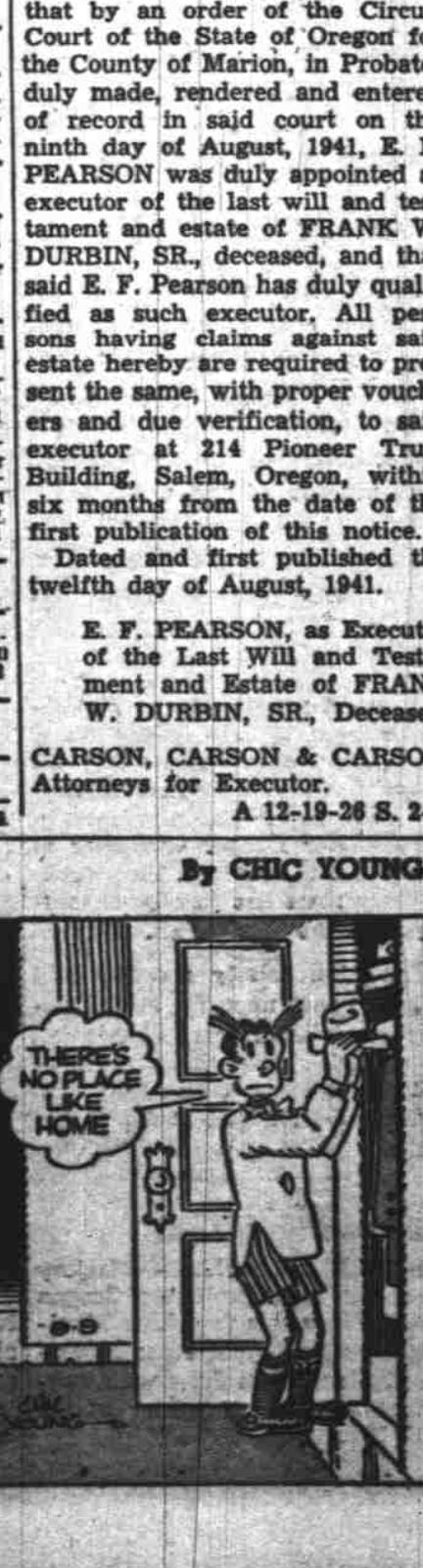
