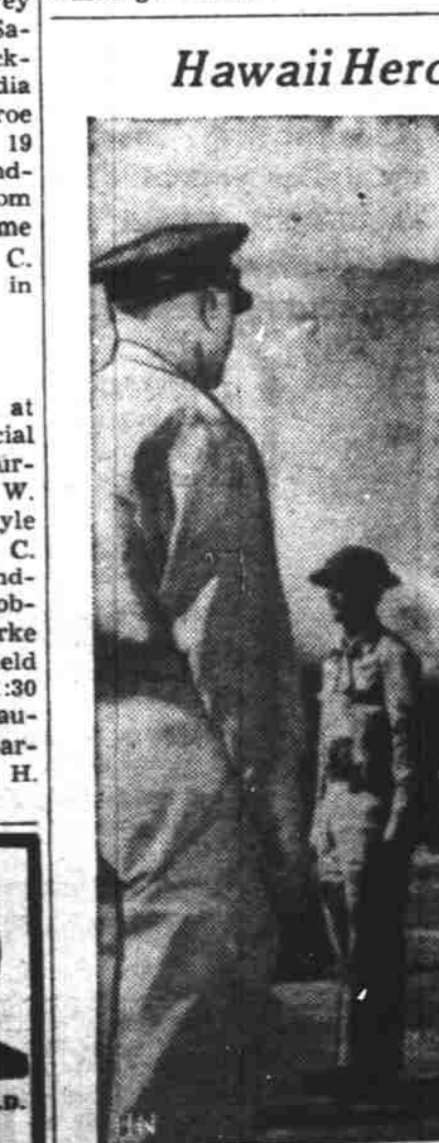
Salem Woman Hurt in Car, Train Crash
