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Hop Mart Dull; Growers Mull Shortage of Wire and Burlap Hop markets on the west coast were seasonally dull and inactive but remained about steady during the week ended January 14, according to the department of agriculture.

California hop markets were quiet but steady with light offerings tending to offset the only moderate demand. No sales of spot hops were reported in the principle producing areas but prices were quoted about unchanged compared with a week ago at around the highs for the current season.

While accurate figures are not available, trade estimates place the supplies of 1941 crop hops remaining in strictly growers' hands at around only 1500 bales, an unusually small figure for this season of the year.

Washington hop markets were dull with demand and trading limited. No spot sales were reported and no new contracts written during the past seven days, although some offerings and offers in each have been made.

Spot supplies were offering at somewhat lower values but contract prices held at about previous levels. Dealers were bidding 35 cents to 36 cents for prime quality 1941 hops with growers generally asking 39 to 40 cents per pound for this type.

Dealers were offering 34-35 cents per pound for 1942 crop regular seeded hops, and 40 to 42 cents per pound for seedless types from the 1942 crop. Growers were not inclined to contract 1942 supplies due to the uncertainty regarding production costs.
