
# Evening Frocks Gay and Appealing

# Canadian Engineers to Blast Underwater Mountains



As the Canadian government prepared to blast twenty feet from the tops of Ripple Rocks Nos. 1 and 2 in Seymour Narrows, this scale model was set up in the outdoor hydraulic laboratory at the University of Washington in Seattle. Long a menace to navigation on the inland route to Alaska, these underwater mountains Victoria and the British Columbia mainland create a natural milirace at ebb and flow tides. Waves 20 feet high of crushing strength make it virtually impossible for ships to hold a fixed course. Ways and means of drilling hundreds of holes for dynamiting will be studied on the scale model.


