of the beautiful summer resort town of Neskowin, owned largely by Salemites, have probably arrived at their destinations (that is the birds have) in Southern California, or Mexico, or Central or South America, as little exhausted as their first few hours out of Alaska or British Columbia, or other points horth on the fringes or islands of the North Pacific ocean.

. . . Says "The Migration of American Birds," the book being quoted from, in some concluding words from the chapters that the reader (if he has persisted) has been reading from:

"While birds that have recently arrived from a protracted flight over land or sea sometimes show evidences of fatigue,

state of exhaustion unless they have encountered unusual conditions such as severe storms with head winds. A few hours' rest and a crop well filled with proper food restore them and they are eager to resume their journey. The notion that birds find the long ocean flights excessively wearisome and that they sink exhausted when terra firma is reached does not agree with observed facts. Actualty, the truth lies in the opposite direction, as even small land birds are so little averse to ocean crossing that they not only cross the Gulf of Mexico at its widest point, but they may even continue without pause over the coastal plain to the higher country beyond."


