

Disappointing Week Closes

Stock Average Off .3 On Week; Coals Show Gains
NEW YORK, Sept. 12.—(AP)—Buying of specialties helped prop Saturday's stock market although leaders generally finished a rather disappointing week without getting anywhere in particular.

The Associated Press average of 60 stock was unchanged at 36.6 but on the week was off .3 of a point. Transfers of 116,450 shares compared with 145,270 a week ago.
