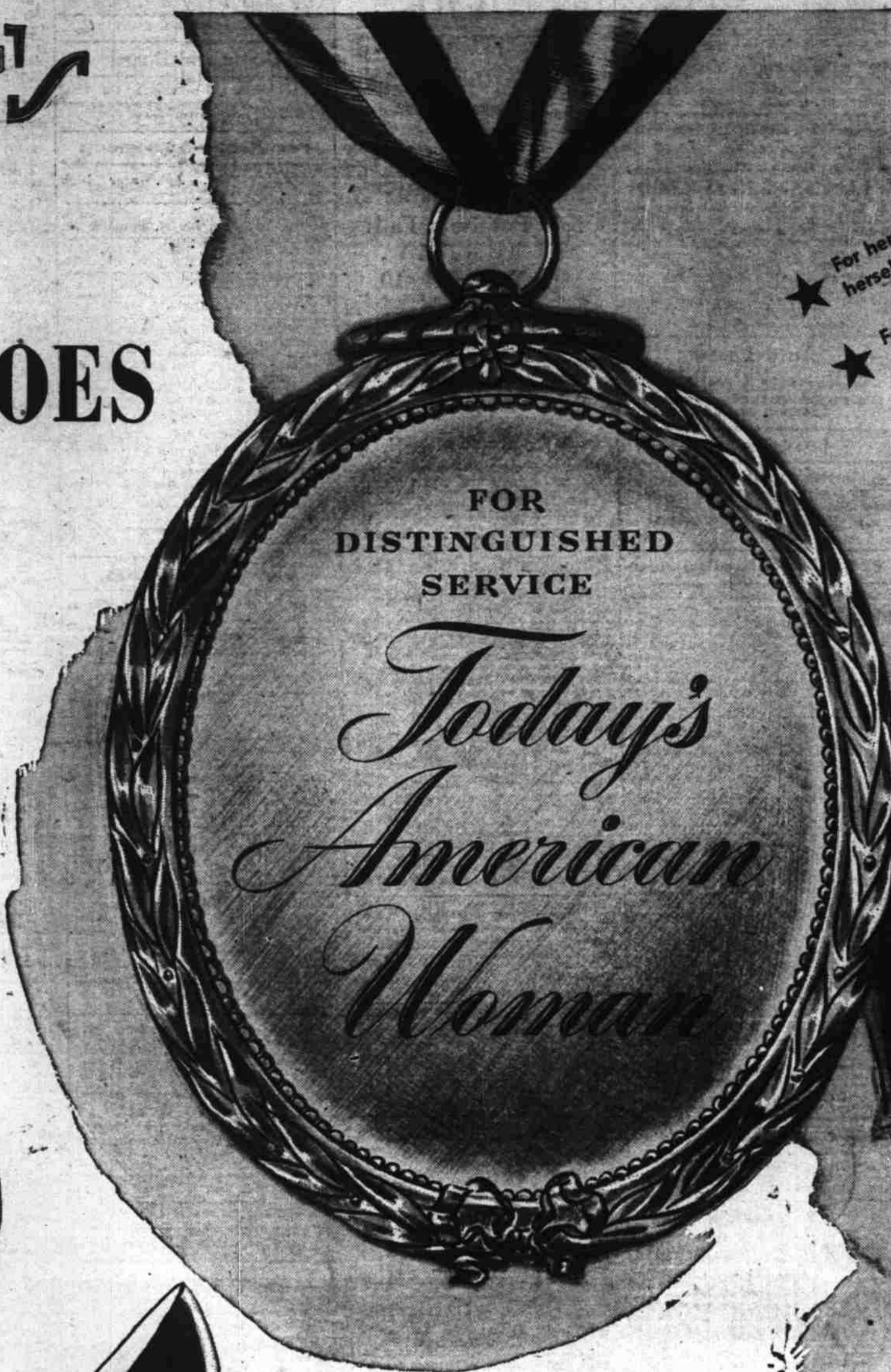

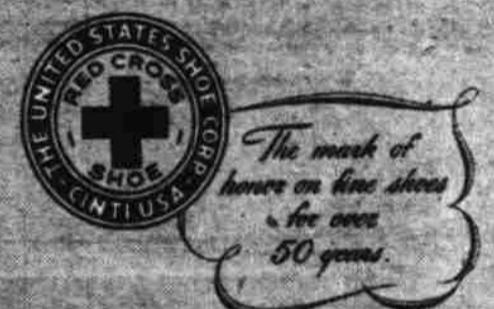
Meeting Postponed
