## Afternoon Dress Type for Wartime Parties



Left, dress in two contrasting colors; center, velveteen frock; right, two-piece date dress

Extremes are out for the duration both in social activities and clothing. Family parties and small groups of friends are more numerous than they have been for years. This type of entertaining has had a distinct influence on our clothes. At such gatherings, whether for dinner or talk, the afternoon type of dress is the passport. Three models of this type are pictured here. Two colors are combined in the dress at the left, which is simple in line, so the dress may be worn at work or play. Soft fullness is provided in front by rows of shirring. Colors may be anything you prefer in shades that go well together. The frock shown center is in velveteen with snug bodice and modified dirndl skirt, and it is made in one of the rich autumn shades. Right is the suit dress which may be worn with or without a blouse. It has jeweled buttons, and the slim silhouette is softened by slightly gathered pleats.
