

Holman Says Bombs Missing

WASHINGTON, Oct. 20 (AP)—Sen. Holman (R-Ore) has testified before a senate appropriations subcommittee that bombing planes were unable to attack an enemy submarine in the Gulf of Mexico because they had no bombs.

During hearings on the second supplemental national defense bill, Holman interrupted witnesses to testify that civilian patrol planes spotted a submarine heading for a tanker off Brownsville, Tex.

The patrol plane, which carried a nephew of Holman's, radioed the location of the submarine, the senator said, but his nephew and the other flyer told him that the six bombers at the station did not attack because they had no bombs.

Rear Adm. E. G. Allen, USN, told the senator that no plane would be out under military control without depth bombs, depth charges, if they were on anti-submarine duty.
