

Much of its Mediterranean coast is mountainous, but there are many potential landing spots, including the area from Rome to Leghorn in the center, with flat coastlines. Railroads run along both coasts, from the tip of the toe to the northern Po valley and the Alps,

The Italian army is estimated at about 1.500,000. The air force numbers from 1500 to 3000 planes; the navy has 80,000 men.

THE BALKAN STATES-Albania, Greece, Yugoslavia, Bulgaria and Rumania-may be thrown open to invasion by the allies if Turkey should join the United Nations.
