Market Breaks To New Losses

No Reason Given for General Retreat; AP Unit Off 5

NEW YORK, June 7.—(AP)—Scattered specialties brested the downward stock market current with some success in Monday's session but many leaders suffered losses of fractions to more than two points.

Brokers found nothing outstanding to account for the general retreat. Profit cashing on the 13-months' upswing may have been one reason.

Mild advances were well distributed at the start. Rails then began to back water as hearings got under way on demands of operating brotherhoods for a 30 per cent wage boost.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was off 5 of a point at 51.7, widest drop in this barometer since May 14.

The market was fairly broad, 920 individual issues being traded. Of these 488 were losers, 233 gainers and 199 unchanged.

Chrysler was a soft spot at one time and ended off 1/4 at 81 notwithstanding the company reported first quarter net of \$1.46 a share compared with \$1.13 in the like 1942 months.

Coast Output Of Lumber Up 111 per Cent

SEATTLE, Washington, June 8.—The weekly average of west coast lumber production in May (four weeks) was 168,621,000 board feet, or 111.9 per cent of 1939-1942 average.

The bottleneck of lumber production remains in log supply, and the great over-all problem still is shortage of man power in the woods. The industry is engaged in a continuing struggle to get back to the production volume of 1942, which is again demanded by the war agencies for 1943.

Orders for 21 weeks of 1943 break down as follows: rail, 2,497,322,000 b. f.; domestic cargo, 246,776,000; export, 70,935,000; local, 440,276,000.

The industry's unfilled order file stood at 1,104,623,000 b. f. at the end of May; gross stocks, at 499,845,000.

Due to our entry into the offensive phase of the war, the demand on the industry is now for a great variety of materials for battle service instead of the construction lumber which formerly went into cantonments, powder factories, warehouses and similar structures.
