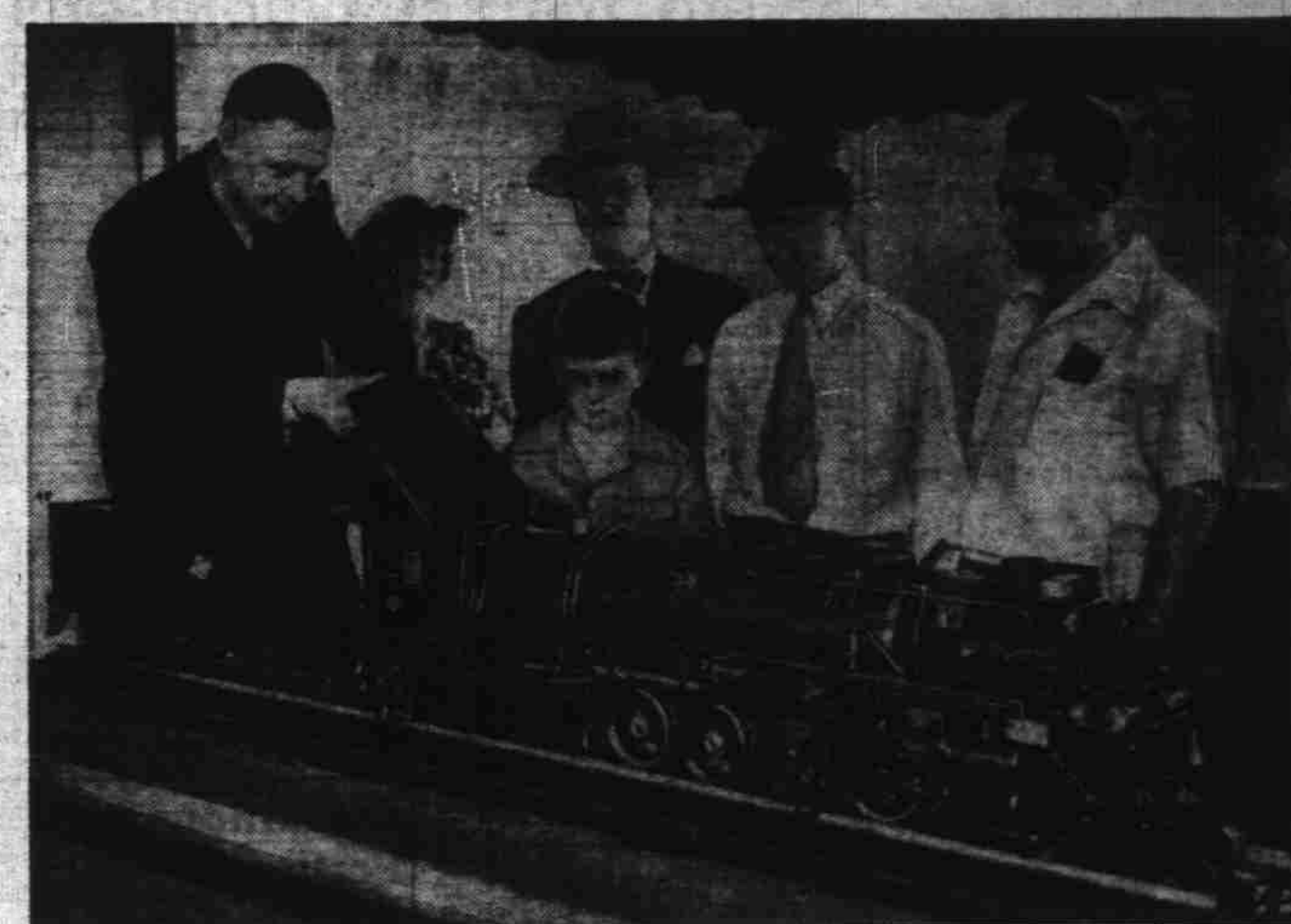
MAINSTAY—Fletcher Mills Candini (above) has been one of the mainstays of the Washington Senators this season.
