# Women Urged To Hold Jobs

WASHINGTON, September 2, (P)-The nation's working women were urged tonight by war man-power officials to stay on their war jobs "despite drudgery, mon-otony and home-making difficulties" - and even if their work holds little glamor.

Participating in a discussion in the Washington Star radio forum on the blue network were Miss Margare Hickey, chairman of the commission's women's advisory committee, R. Randall Irwin, executive assistant to the management members of the WMC management-labor policy committee, and Miss Elizabeth Christman, alternate member of the WMC women's advisory committee and secretary treasurer of the national women's trade union league of America.

Miss Hickey declared that women in surplus labor areas should "stay right where they are unless the local United States employment office tells them to move."

The labor needs in already jammed war production centers, Miss Hickey added, "must be filled by women non-workers already in the over-crowded community. That means women of all ages, from all walks of life, of all creeds and color, must step in and take their rightful place in the battle

Irwin, assistant to the vice president of the Lockheed and Vega Aircraft corporation, said that one southern California aircraft factory "is losing women employes faster than it can hire them." "It is not enough for a woman merely to dake a war job," he said. "It is just as important, if




