- ★ October 3, 1943, will be World Wide Communion Sunday when Christians of all races in many lands will come in penitence and faith to the Lord's Table.
- ★ In marked contrast to our divided and war-victimized world, Christians everywhere must maintain their fellowship unbroken and unbreakable. In this, lies the hope for the salvation of tomorrow's world.
- ★ Each Christian, no matter in what part of the world he lives, will witness to the enduring fellowship which abides in the body of Christ, which is the Church, by his presence at the Lord's Table.
- ★ The 30% attendance which was average in Protestant churches in the United States a year ago is too small to generate the energy the church will need for its spiritual services in this critical war period.
